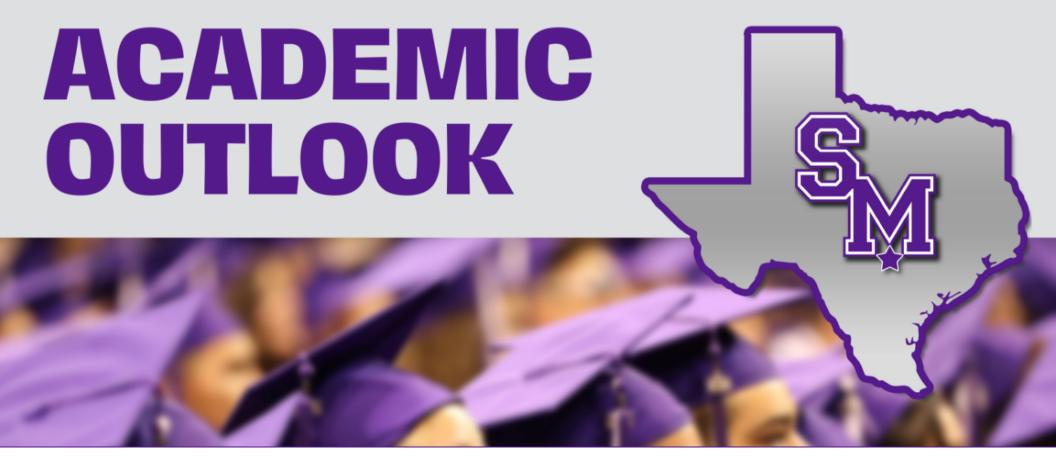

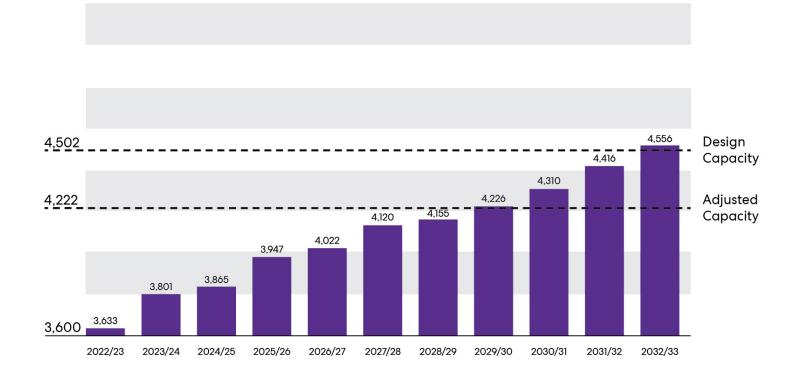

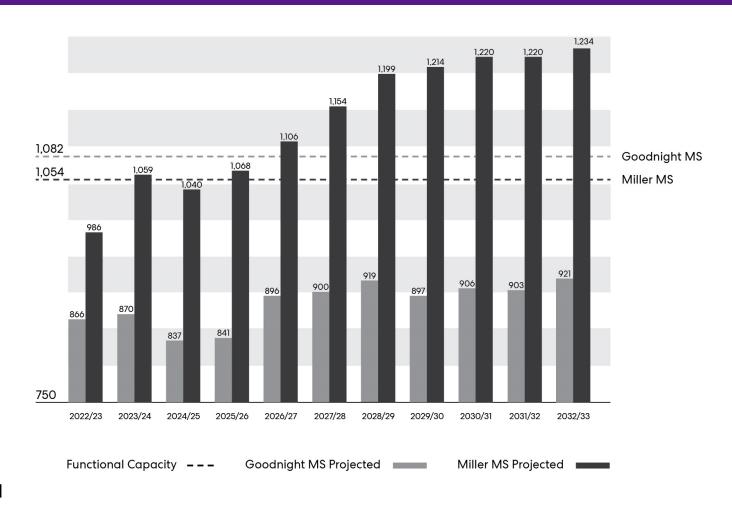




Total Projected Elementary Enrollment

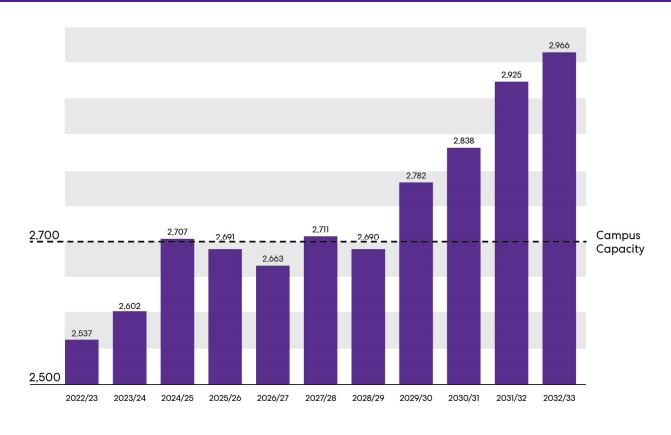

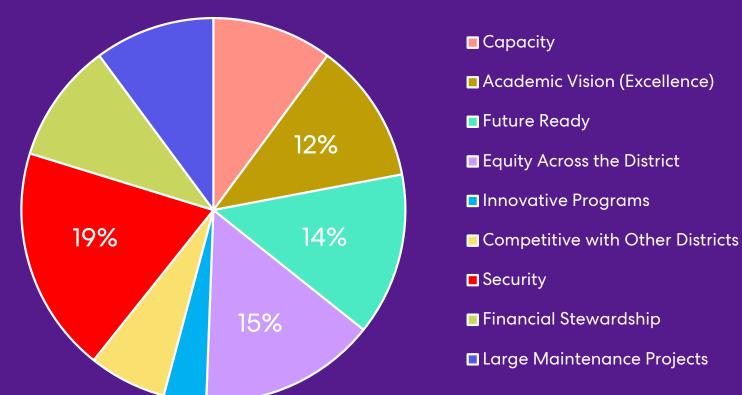
Total Projected High School Enrollment
